Ke'Aina Kai Townhomes-Bylaws Article VIII, section 2(h), states, "No owner or occupant of an Apartment shall, without the prior written approval of the Board, install any wiring for electrical or telephone installations, machines or air conditioning units, television or other antennas, satellite dishes, or other equipment or appurtenances whatsuever on the exterior of the Project or protruding through the walls, windows, or roof thereof. "Owner will be required to receive written approval from the Ke'Aina Kai Townhomes Board of Directors prior to any installation.


